NOTES

- You are entitled to appoint another person as your proxy to exercise all or any of your rights to attend and to speak and vote at the meeting.

If you wish to appoint someone other than the chair of the meeting to act as your proxy, insert the name of the person you wish to appoint in block capitals in the space provided. Where you appoint someone other than the chair, you are responsible for ensuring that they attend the meeting and are aware of your voting intentions.
- To be effective, this proxy form, fully completed, together with the power of attorney or any other authority under which it is executed (or a solicitor's certified copy), must be lodged with the Charity at 15 Old Ford Road, Bethnal Green, London, E2 9PJ or by email to mail@stamma.org by 9am on Friday 9th October.
- 4 If the member is a corporation, this proxy form should be executed under its common seal, or signed on its behalf by a duly authorised officer or attorney.
- The completion and return of this proxy form will not prevent a member from attending the meeting and voting in person (or, in the case of a corporate member, by its corporate representative attending and voting in person).
- A member is entitled to terminate the appointment of its proxy by notifying the proxy and the Charity of the termination or by appointing a new proxy in place of the original proxy.
