


ABOUT STAMMA

By making your Will through The National Free Wills Network or Farewill, you'll be connected with a qualified solicitor. They'll help you write or amend a simple Will for free.

By taking advantage of our Will-writing service, you are **not** obliged to include a gift to STAMMA. However, after taking care of your loved ones we'd be honoured if you'd consider leaving a gift to us. And help us change the lives of children and adults long into the future.

Choose your free Will Service today

WITH A LOCAL SOLICITOR

The **National Free Wills Network** has a list of expert solicitors across the UK who can write or update your Will for free, in person or remotely.

Once you've given us your details you'll receive a pack which includes a list of local participating solicitors. Then, select a solicitor and book an appointment. Your pack should arrive within five working days.

ONLINE

Alternatively, you can write your Will online from the comfort of your own home with support from **Farewill**. This service is available in England and Wales for those aged 18 or over. Go to <https://farewill.com/stamma> to start.

BY PHONE

Call Farewill on **0208 050 2686** and quote 'STAMMA' to book a free phone appointment with one of their Will-writing specialists. Alternatively, go to <https://farewill.com/stamma-phone> to arrange a call-back. The service is available throughout the UK, offering specialist support for complex needs and personal guidance. Farewill's team are available Monday to Friday 9am-6pm.
